Student's Feedback Report

(Academic Year-2020-2021)

The comprehensive feedback report is as follows:

Point 1: Due to COVID-19 only 68 students of the college participated in feedback and 97% of them were UG students. Only 3% of PG students participated in the Feedback process.

Point 2: About 71% of students believe that teaching should be done in both online as well as offline mode.

Point-3: Faculty-wise student participation is: Arts-60%, Commerce-37%, and Science-1.4%.

Point 4: About 73% of students are satisfied with the teaching methodology adopted by teachers and say that concepts were explained to them with examples. The remaining students indicated that concepts were explained with illustrations only occasionally.

Point 5: The majority of students say that the medium of instruction in the class was both English and Hindi.

Point 6: About 88% of students believe that the internal evaluation was fair. About 12% of students believed that at times their internal evaluations were not fair.

Point 7: About 80% of students could understand more than 75% of the lecture content. About 20% of the students could understand only half of the lecture content.

Point 8: About 34% of student's internal evaluations were based on written exams, oral tests, and assignments. About 43% of the students were evaluated through assignments only.

Point-9: 35% of students rate their instructor's communication skills as excellent and 40% of students say very well. About 25% of the students graded their instructor's communication skills as good.

Point 10: 97% of students believe that their mentor's guidance was helpful. 3% of students believe that their mentors were of no help to them.

Point 11: About 89% of students indicated that more than 75% of the syllabus was covered by their instructors. The remaining students say that less than 75% syllabus was covered in their classes.

Point-12: About 26% of students strongly believe that the quality of education in college is very good. About 62% of the students say it is good.

Point 13: About 26% of students found their teachers very helpful in resolving their academic issues. About 62% of the students believe that their teachers helped resolve their emotional and personal issues.

Point 14: About 21% of students say that college must have courses on soft skills, life skills, and employable skills. About 66% of the students believe that these courses will be useful for them.

Point-15: 18% of students believe that college library facilities are very good whereas 66% of students think they are good.



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Action Taken Report
(Academic year-2020-2021)

In view of feedback report prepared by the feedback-committee and submitted to the principal, the college administration will initiate following actions to implement the committee recommendations:

1. **Blended mode of Teaching:** The teachers of the college have been requested to make teaching learning a dual-mode process.
2. **Internal Evaluation System:** A meeting of teachers was held and a consensus was reached to make internal evaluation system a more transparent and fair mechanism.
3. **Mentoring:** The mentors were being requested to be more serious and sincere in guiding their students.
4. **Introduction of soft-skill Courses:** The College will initiate necessary measures to introduce courses such as soft-skills, life- skills and employable-skills as soon as possible.



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
