**DSC (In Semester I to IV)**

**Paper -1 Introduction to Sociology**

**Paper-2 Sociology of India**

## **SEC (In Semester III to VI)**

### **Paper-1 Techniques of Social Research**

- It will provide students with some elementary knowledge on how to conduct both, quantitative and qualitative research.
